
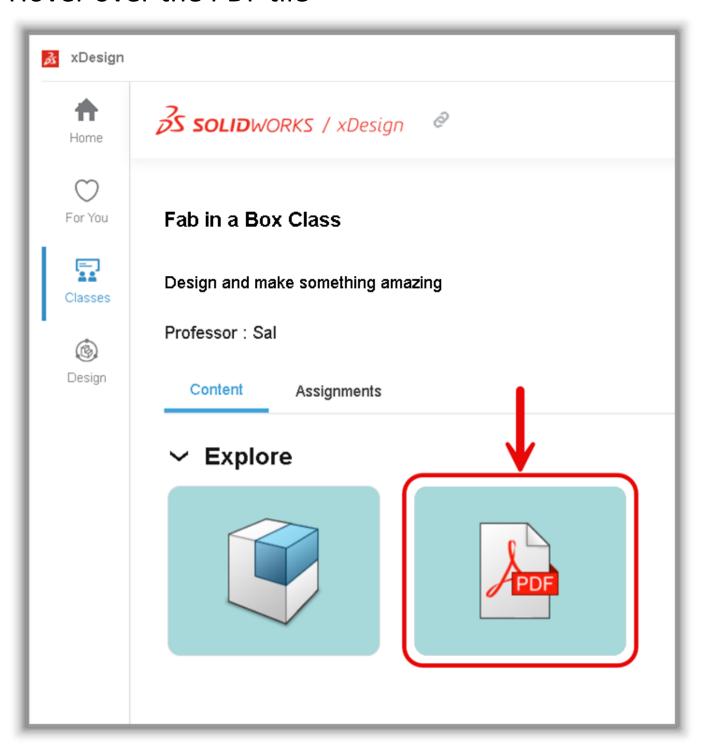


1. Click the Classes tab




2. Hover over the PDF tile

4. Hover over the "Paper Pop-ups - Designing Dynamic Greeting Cards" tile



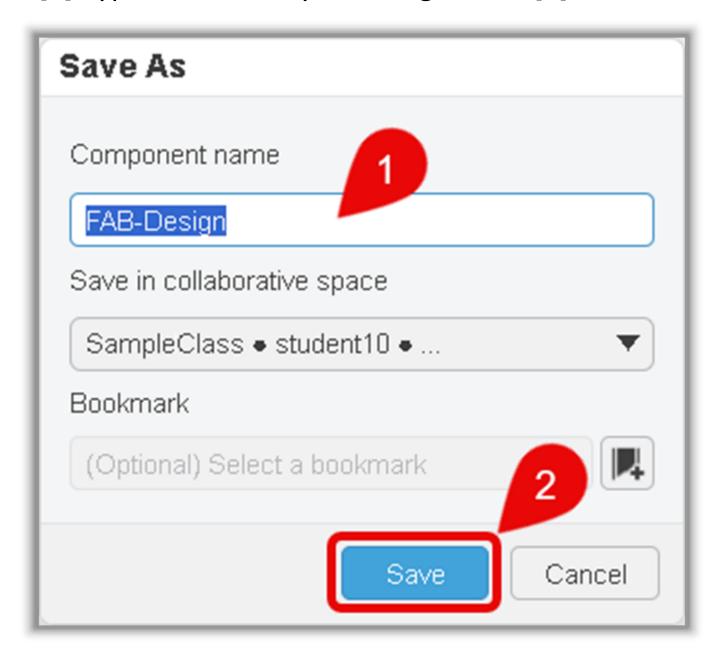
5. Click **OPEN**




6. Click Save As on the Standard tab of the Action Bar




7. [1] Type a name for your design, then [2] click **Save**



8. Double-click the "Your Text" sketch in the Design Manager




- 9. Press "N" on the keyboard to look normal to (straight at) the sketch
- 10. Drag a box around the word "FAB" to select it




11. Press "Delete" on the keyboard.

12. Click the "Text" command on the keyboard



13. Type your initials into the Text box




- 14. Move your mouse around the screen and notice how the text follows.
- 15. Experiment with the font type, size, and more, moving your mouse around the sticker to make sure it'll fit the way you want.

16. Click the "OK" checkmark at the top of the dialog




--- Notice that the text appears at the origin

18. Click the "Accept Sketch" button to update your sticker



19. Click "Save" on the Action Bar to save your sticker



20. Double-click the "Your Text" sketch to edit it again and add decorations to it using the "Circle", "Rectangle", and other tools




Sample Decorations

22. Click "Save" on the Action Bar to save your sticker




FABRICATE YOUR POP-UP

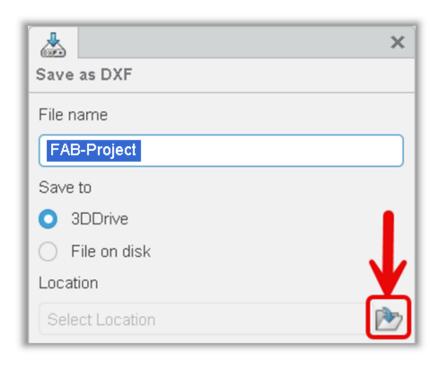
 Click the **DXF** command on the Tools tab of the Action Bar



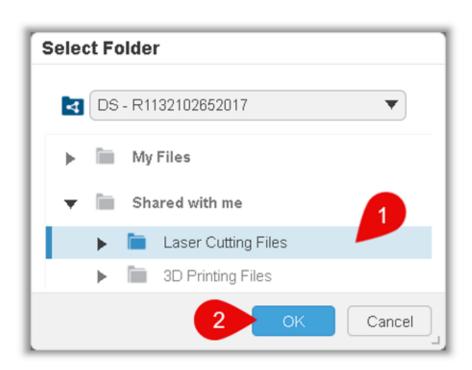
2. Select the large flat face of your pop-up card — **NOTE:** You can also select any disconnected pieces to include in your DXF file, but they will not be connected to your pop-up card unless you attach them in some other way




3. Click the Location folder button



4. [1] Select the folder your instructor told you to use to save your files then [2] click **OK**



5. Click the Save button in the Save as DXF dialog
