



Emotions in Motion

Lesson Plan

ZONE: Creativity Zone

AGE: 6-13
(special needs)

EQUIPMENT : Access to the internet and a computer, Makey Makey kit, activity template, scissors, 8 brass fasteners per child, 5 metallic U pins.

DESCRIPTION:

This session explores the role of emotions and how they can be expressed through colors, shapes, and sounds. Children will engage in an interactive activity using the Makey Makey electronic kit to create an interactive emotion-expressing poster.

DESIGN CHALLENGE:

The challenge is to understand how using the same facial elements—rotated with brass fasteners—can express a full range of emotions through movement and composition.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

By the end of this session, participants will:

- Understand how to use the Bouba and Kiki concept, along with color theory, to express different emotions.
- Learn how to create a simple circuit using Makey Makey and grasp the basics of electrical flow.
- Express a variety of emotions through the interactive Makey Makey-based platform.

DURATION	ACTIVITY	MATERIALS
1h	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cut out the different elements from the template with the support of the educators.• Assemble your face using the cut-out pieces—follow your creativity! Colored paper will be available if you'd like to add extra elements.• Attach the metallic U pins to the emotion cut-outs.• Connect the emotions to the Makey Makey using alligator clips.• Plug in the Makey Makey and open the interactive platform: https://apps.makeymakey.com/poster/• Assign each emotion to a selfie using your face cut-out.• Add a sound to each emotion.• Test your interactive poster—explore the different emotions, and don't forget to take pictures with other participants!
