English Comprehension & Reasoning	Accurately identifies characters' feelings and provides clear, detailed reasons supported by the story. Speaks confidently and elaborates ideas.	Correctly identifies feelings and provides relevant reasons with some support from the story. Participates actively in discussion.	Identifies some feelings but gives simple or unclear reasons. Needs prompting to elaborate.
SEL Empathy & Kindness	Demonstrates strong understanding of empathy and kindness, makes meaningful real-life connections, and expresses thoughtful reflections.	Shows clear understanding of kindness and empathy and can explain how actions affect others' feelings.	Shows basic awareness of kindness but explanations are limited or general.
Art – Creative Expression	Artwork clearly shows strong use of warm/cool colours, varied brush strokes, and rhythm using lines and dots. Visual elements work together to strongly express a chosen feeling (e.g. joyful, calm, energetic, hopeful).	Artwork shows appropriate use of colours, some texture and rhythm, and a clear attempt to express a feeling.	Artwork shows limited use of colour, texture or rhythm, and the intended feeling is unclear or weakly expressed.
Technology – Micro:bit	Confidently uses Micro:bit to respond, customise code, and/or send messages. Demonstrates clear understanding of how the program works	Uses Micro:bit correctly to respond and/or modify simple code. Shows basic understanding of how the program works.	Uses Micro:bit with guidance; has difficulty modifying code.
